

MORGAN COUNTY BOARD OF TAX ASSESSORS
Appraiser Trainee

The Morgan County Board of Assessors is accepting applications for the position of Appraiser Trainee in the Assessor's office. This position appraises real property to determine fair market value for ad valorem tax purposes. This position requires both fieldwork and office work. Must be able to prepare and present information to the public and other staff members. Experience in real estate or construction will be helpful. Candidates with current Georgia Department of Revenue certification are encouraged to apply but will also consider training someone who is career-minded and has a strong desire to succeed. Starting salary for Appraiser Trainee is \$ 35,060.73 and starting salary for a Certified Appraiser is \$38,700.49. Position has the chance for advancement through certification levels.

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. High School Diploma or GED equivalency, current valid driver's license, and at least 21 years of age.
2. Candidates must have or be able to obtain Appraiser I Certification from the GA Dept. of Revenue within the first year of employment.
3. Must have proficient computer and math skills.
4. Must possess excellent written and verbal communication skills.
5. Job requires attending out-of-town classes.
